

#### HP WoW (World on Wheels)

#### HP-CLAP (Continued Learning Access Program)

Through this impactful initiative, we are committed to empowering students from economically weaker sections (EWS) and government schools, who often lack proper access to computer labs. Each day, 120 computing devices, pre-loaded with valuable course content, are shared on a rotational basis in a vehicle across three different locations. Students in classes 7 to 10 receive 3.5 hours of immersive learning, with the devices acting as gateways to new opportunities. To ensure uninterrupted learning, our mobile unit is fully equipped with a laptop charging cart, generator, and battery backup, allowing us to recharge the devices during transit. Once the session concludes, the laptops are returned, and the vehicle moves on to the next location - extending hope, knowledge, and opportunity to even more eager young minds.

To gain an in-depth understanding of the impact of our CSR initiatives, we collaborated with Grant Thornton Bharat LLP (GT), a respected consulting firm. This comprehensive study assesses the effectiveness of our programs, such as the Samarth-Jyoti Vocational Training Centre and Samarth-Jyoti Community School, in various states including Haryana, Uttarakhand, Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, and Rajasthan. The objective of this engagement is to evaluate the outcomes of our CSR projects for beneficiaries, focusing on aspects such as increased income and employability, skill enhancement, and improved access to primary education.

### **Vocational and Skill Training**

### BACKGROUND

The Vocational and Skill Training program is dedicated to fostering the economic and social advancement of women and adolescent girls. This initiative aims to empower the target beneficiaries by equipping them with new skills and facilitating access to meaningful employment opportunities, thereby enabling them to achieve socioeconomic independence.

Two primary courses - Beauty and Culture, and Cutting & Tailoring - were provided at the training centres, each with a duration of six months. This study conducted interviews with women who completed these courses between 2012 and 2021.

The project team conducted in-depth interactions with beneficiaries at the training centres. The planned sample for coverage represented 5% of the total certified candidates, and the study successfully achieved 100% coverage of this planned sample during the interviews.

The transformative programs of the Suman Nirmal Minda Foundation are deeply inspiring and it is both a privilege and a source of pride working alongside dedicated teams. Through our programs we have empowered beneficiaries, improved health outcomes, and created new economic opportunities. ### BACKGROUND

The Samarth-Jyoti Community School education program aims to provide informal primary education to children from Nursery to Class III. Many migrant families and other disadvantaged groups face barriers to accessing quality education due to limited disposable income and challenges in fostering sustained interest in learning among children. The centre provides essential facilities and support to help children transition into formal education. Additionally, it offers remedial classes for students from primary level to Class XII. To further build skills, IT literacy training is provided to government school students, enhancing their computer proficiency.

This study assessed all community and remedial students based on grade-appropriate competencies aligned with NCERT learning outcome guidelines. Additionally, separate evaluations were conducted to measure the importance and effectiveness of IT literacy and coaching classes.

### **Qualitative Findings**

- An alternative teaching approach was used to cultivate curiosity and also deepen understanding of topics
- Students were confident and attentive during the interview
- 74% of coaching beneficiaries and 73% of IT skills beneficiaries reported increased self-confidence








